

CLEANING FABRIC

Please always refer to your specific fabric cleaning requirements, as they vary from range to range. However, no matter what fabric you have, regular light dusting will help keep it looking its best. Use a feather duster, cloth, or vacuum with soft brush attachments. For a thorough cleaning, we recommend professional dry cleaning.

CLEANING HARDWARE

To clean curtain hardware, dust with a feather duster, cloth, or soft brush attachment on your vacuum. Then, spot clean using warm, soapy water.

PROTECTION

Never spray cleaning products directly onto your curtain or you may damage the fabric. When cleaning windows behind curtains, avoid contact with your curtains by always spraying glass cleaner directly onto your cleaning cloth before wiping down the glass. Cleaning products with an alcohol-based solution may tarnish the curtain's hardware components and are best avoided. Never immerse hardware in cleaning solutions or liquids of any kind.



RECOMMENDED COASTAL CLEANING SCHEDULE

CORROSION POTENTIAL	DISTANCE TO SALT-WATER	CLEANING SCHEDULE
Low	20km radius	Every 6 months
Moderate	10km radius	Every 3 months
High	1km radius	Every 3 weeks
Extreme	500m radius	Every week
